# **BAEOP MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP**

## **TUITION REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES**

1. Must be a BAEOP member at the time of application and remain a member until scholarship funds are awarded. If their BAEOP membership should lapse, they will not receive the scholarship funds.
2. Must have been a BAEOP member for a minimum of two (2) current consecutive years at the time of application.
3. Must be working toward earning their PSP Certificate or PSP Recertification.
4. Scholarship awards must be claimed within one-year following award date.
5. Applicant must complete the application form and attach an essay on "Why I Am Applying for a Member Scholarship." Include educational/professional goals and how this scholarship meets your current need for assistance.
6. Include one letter of recommendation from an individual in the field of education.
7. All applications and accompanying information must be emailed or hand delivered to the BAEOP Scholarship Chairperson by May 1st of the current school year.
8. Recipient will be chosen by an impartial panel of judges made up of BAEOP members.
9. The BAEOP Scholarship Chairperson will notify each recipient of the award and the winners will be recognized at the Year-End Banquet.
10. The BAEOP Treasurer will reimburse up to \$200.00 to each scholarship recipients for educational expenses, following completion of a class, workshop, or conference. Recipients must provide proof of attendance to receive the reimbursement.
